
#### **Events:**









#### 2021-2022




The number of cultural and Sports Events were less due to the pandemic situation

Wayanad is a small hill District in Kerala with an area of 2131 km2. Wayanad District come into being on Nov.1, 1980. It has a population about 9 lakhs of which 90% depend upon agriculture for sustenance. The District has the highest tribal population as well. seven though, in terms, wayanad is derived from the word "Vayal Nad", which means the land of paddy helds. Now it is no more the land of paddy fileds. It is fomous for its spices and coffee plantation now.

In 1980, there were 30,000 hectors of paddy fields in Wayanad. It has shimk by more than 76 precent to 7000 hector at present. The ecosytem and environement of the district, which is famous for its biodivesity is greatly endangered today.

We are facing scarcity to land and water today due to industrilisation and urbanization. this change in defienlty affects ecosystem and socio-economic conditions. Hence existing land use and the relationship between population growth and food production is a matter of concern.

Contiues to be staple food of Malayalies, even though food consumption pattern of the majority of households underwent significant changes in past few decades. In these scenario the performance of paddy faim sector in wayanad is quite disappointing. Being a consumer state, with recent production hence, the district and state in general feilds to be moving towards food insecurity.

Agricultural fond convesion especially that of paddy fields, has been a business issue both from the perspective of food security and its enviormnental impacts. Thought agricultural land conversions have been banned under kerala land ultilized order, convertion have been occuing in cm umprecedoned manner in wayanad. The major reason for land conversion in wayanad is the pressave from other remuners alive crops like banana, cocount and growth of construction sector. Today fields in wayanad, further many reglected paddy lands have naturally evolved as a dense scrubland. Problems like acute labour shortage, availability of rice for imports from neighbouring states, supply of rice through PDS, change in policy focus of diffecent governemnts, etc, also affect the decline in the area and production of paddy in Wayanad.

For improving the paddy cultivation in wayanad kerala in general the government should take necessary actions. This includes actions like providing minimum support price for paddy, mechanization of agricultural operation must be done, better irrigation facilities should be provided and most importantly there should be positive change in the general attitude towards rise cultivation. If necessary steps are not taken our district "Wayanad" will no more be a land of paddy fileds as its name suggest.
